BOTTOM LINE: Legislators who voted for SB5 earn an average of nearly \$68,000 per year and receive over \$3,000 to drive to work for a part-time job. Legislators are not limited in the amount of sick, personal or vacation leave time they may use, while SB5 caps the number of paid days off for other public employees.
