
### **OH-12 HEALTHCARE OVERVIEW**

On August 7th, Ohio's 12th Congressional District will decide who will be its next representative in Washington. No issue has more at stake in this election than healthcare.

### The District has benefited greatly from the Affordable Care Act



Prior to President Obama's ACA going into effect, 9.2%<sup>2</sup> of residents in OH-12 were uninsured. That number is now 4.1%.<sup>3</sup>

## Premium costs for ACA plans are expected to rise

Premium costs are expected to rise by \$800 in Ohio due to the Trump Administration's efforts to undermine the program which includes its repeal of the individual mandate in the tax bill.
